# Day 1: Arrival at Catania - Ragusa (Meals: -D; transport: 1h 30min)

Upon leaving Catania Airport, we are welcomed by our hosts and set off for the magnificent city of Ragusa. We settle into an intimate estate, nestled in the heart of lush nature. Here, in this little corner of paradise, we gently find our bearings and take time to enjoy the property and its surroundings. Immersed in an authentic natural setting, we delight in fragrant gardens overflowing with flowers, fruit trees, and olive groves. The picturesque, bucolic charm of the place is appreciated to the fullest. The intoxicating mix offered by La Villa Dolce Valle invites us to reconnect — with ourselves, with others, with the sweetness of life, and above all, with the timeless tranquillity of days gone by.

The swimming pool, a true oasis framed by local stone walls, is shaded by lush greenery. This stunning pool awaits, promising a moment of pure relaxation. Or perhaps we prefer to settle into one of the many quiet corners hidden within the estate's 10 hectares of natural beauty?

In the evening, we savour our first Sicilian meal, a feast for the senses. Prepared with love by a nutritionist, it's also a moment to share stories about the place with our hosts and to plan our adventures for the days ahead.

Enjoy our first night in the serenity of limitless nature. Overnight stay at Villa Dolce Valle in a Villappart.

## Day 2: Ragusa - Bucolic and Rural Sicily (Meals: BLD; transport: none; 3-hour walk)

This very first breakfast, enjoyed beneath an almost-guaranteed Sicilian sun, is pure delight. Let's take the time to savour the moment! A tempting spread awaits — from sweet to savoury, with fruit picked straight from the garden, traditional Sicilian specialities and fresh local produce. And of course, no stay would be complete without tasting one of the countless Sicilian creations made with ricotta.

Let's set off on foot from our accommodation to explore one of the region's best-preserved canyons. Its many unique features never fail to surprise: rare botanical and geological curiosities, ancient mule tracks, incredibly diverse vegetation, winding riverbeds, unexpected pine groves, and little-known wild herbs. While the richness of the flora is unparalleled, the springs and caves that dot our route are equally captivating. We'll enhance this excursion with visits to old mills and a historic convent, places steeped in history and unique energy. The outing concludes with a simple yet flavoursome lunch, served as a comfortable picnic in the heart of nature.

Return to our villa and enjoy some free time. The Sicilian siesta is not to be taken lightly! Depending on our mood, a variety of other options are, of course, available during this restful pause.

At the end of the day, we embrace the gifts of nature in this season. We gather fresh produce from the estate's vegetable garden and dive into preparing a typical Sicilian meal. Then, we share our creations in a convivial table d'hôte setting, soaking up the vibrant "volcanic" spirit of Sicily.

## Day 3: From magical coves to a traditional fishing village (Meals: BLD; transport: +/- 2h 30min; 3,5-hour walk)

The stunning beaches of south-eastern Sicily are among the wildest on the island. Often adorned with fine golden sand, these seemingly endless stretches can also appear as small bays or secluded crescent-shaped coves.

By car, we set off to explore places of rare authenticity, where history intertwines with the beauty of nature. Today's visit takes us to a nature reserve set in an enchanting landscape. Its dense vegetation, crystal-clear sea, and fine sandy beaches — nesting grounds for the famous loggerhead turtles — are just part of its richness. It is also a gathering point for hundreds of migratory birds, including magnificent flamingos, storks, cormorants, and many other species. The remnants of ancient civilizations, from Greek to Byzantine and Swabian, complete this extraordinary and unforgettable setting.

We explore all these wonders on foot. A beachside picnic offers a much-needed pause before a well-deserved swim.

In the mid-afternoon, let's explore a quintessential fishing village, a must-see in southern Sicily. Treat yourself to the classic Spritz, delicious pistachio granita, and enjoy a leisurely stroll among the colourful local stalls.

We end the day with a well-deserved, delicious meal at Dolce Valle!

## Day 4: Immersion day - Between nature, beekeeping, and cooking (Meals: BLD; transport: +/- 2h)

A gentle start to the day by the pool with a yoga session — your body will thank you!

A hearty breakfast to start the day, followed by time spent with a dedicated farmer and beekeeper, committed to Sicily's future and the preservation of nature. Explore his estate, his crops, his projects, his daily life, the challenges he faces, and his hopes for the future.

Enjoy a lively and convivial lunch shared with Nicolo.

His estate, nestled within the Santo Pietro wood, is home to hundreds of bees. Experience the fascinating world of beekeeping alongside him and learn more about the delicate art of managing these incredible creatures.

In the early evening, Nicolo, together with his friends and family, guides us through the traditional Sicilian art of pizzamaking in his wood-fired oven. A truly Sicilian atmosphere is guaranteed!

## Day 5: Relaxing and cultural day (Meals: BL-; transport: +/- 1h 30min)

Let's begin the day gently and set out to explore a little-known historic and aristocratic site. Immerse yourself in the history of a Sicily that often goes unnoticed. Take the time to wander through this sumptuous and romantic setting, where the ingenuity of the past offers fascinating insights into life under the summer sun.

Let's take a moment to pause and enjoy a delicious picnic by the sea. Embrace the pace of Dolce Far Niente: on land or in the water, it's time to follow your whims (with optional paddleboarding or snorkeling). After a savoury seaside break, indulge in a sweet treat — the classic Italian ice cream or granita is a must!

Let's linger a little longer in the art of Dolce Far Niente, now mastered like true Sicilians, around the Dolce Valle pool. In the evening, we'll dress in our finest and head to a charming and unique local restaurant :-)

## Day 6: Baroque City - Natural pool and Antique Ruins (Meals: BLD; transport: +/- 2h 30min; 3-hour walk)

The drive itself is an adventure! Winding roads thread through Sicilian valleys, past sun-scorched fields and countless other Sicilian treasures that punctuate this picturesque countryside route.

Let's follow in the footsteps of the ancient city of Noto, often described as a "medieval Pompeii." The old city, destroyed by the earthquake that devastated Sicily in 1693, tells its story through its ruins. Marvel at the remnants of a civilisation buried beneath the rubble, and descend into the depths of an impressive canyon.

Next, let's take a dip in an extraordinary natural pool. The spot is perfect for enjoying our picnic and taking a moment to rest before ascending the historic steps of this ancient civilisation.

Let's visit the new city of Noto, the finest example of Baroque architecture. Take in the view from above and admire the full power and beauty of the city from its rooftops. Don't miss the chance to taste some of Sicily's iconic culinary specialities.

Dinner and overnight at Villa Dolce Valle.

Note: A more cultural alternative (without hiking) is available: explore Sicilian history across the centuries. The site immerses you in the magic of ancient beliefs and offers insight into the various mystical cults of ancient Sicily (ancient temple, amphitheatre, necropolis...).

## Day 7: Rural experiences - Villa Dolce Valle (Meals: BL-; transport: none; 1-hour walk)

A gentle, blissful day awaits you.

If the first yoga session by the pool left you feeling refreshed, you're invited to relive that moment of happiness! The pool is always there to rejuvenate and delight you.

As every morning, we begin with a discovery breakfast, before celebrating the art of Dolce Far Niente. Let's also benefit from the knowledge of the local farmers: learn more about caring for the estate's trees, the constant and never-ending work of the vegetable garden, and, if we wish, roll up our sleeves and join in...

Next, let's savour a well-deserved free afternoon, whether relaxing by the pool, strolling around the estate, or enjoying special activities (on request) — anything is possible!

In the late afternoon, let's head on foot to the nearby Baroque town of Ragusa Ibla. Transitioning from the pastoral countryside to this Sicilian city with a rich historical past, we discover a place renowned worldwide for its fifty or so churches and numerous palaces. Don't miss the crowning jewel of Hyblan Baroque, the Cathedral of San Giorgio. As we stroll, we gradually immerse ourselves in the charming Baroque atmosphere. This legendary city is indeed welcoming, its history vividly told through the unique character of its architecture.

Let's celebrate our final evening on the terrace of a traditional restaurant in the old town.

Return by car. Overnight stay at Villa Dolce Valle.

## Day 8: The Natural Pools of Cava Grande - Palazzolo Acreide (Meals: BL-; Transport: approx. 2h30)

Let's set off to explore the natural pools of the Cavagrande Cassibile Nature Reserve. The drive itself is an adventure, with views of sun-scorched fields and secluded villages as we wind our way into the heart of the Sicilian valleys. The excitement builds piano piano as we follow the narrow paths leading to the entrance of this impressive canyon.

Sicilian prehistory unfolds before us in all its glory, and the natural pools provide the perfect spot to relax after a good half-hour walk. It's an ideal place to enjoy a picnic, take a refreshing dip, and unwind before setting off again.

In the late afternoon, let's explore a typical town and embrace the art of Dolce Far Niente. Indulge in the classic Spritz and enjoy a delicious Italian bruschetta in the main square, beneath the magnificent church that overlooks the town.

Return to Villa Dolce Valle to end the evening with a hearty plate of Italian pasta.

## Day 9: Scicli, Modica and the Randello Nature Reserve (Meals: B-D; Transport: 2h)

Today, a few gems of Baroque Sicily await us. Let's visit the charming towns of Scicli and Modica. Wander through their authentic streets, soak up the Sicilian way of life, savour the famous cannoli, and discover the secrets behind Modica's renowned chocolate.

After a hearty meal in these historic surroundings, let's take a break on a beach within the Randello Nature Reserve. We'll pass through a forest of cypress, eucalyptus, myrtle, and oak before arriving at a beach still largely unknown to tourists.

Let's savour our final night at the Dolce Valle estate.

## Day 10: Discovering Mamma Etna and Tasting Local Specialities (Meals: B-; Transport: approx. 2h30)

Let's head to the coast and make our way slowly towards the impressive Mount Etna. Giuseppe accompanies us, sharing his experience and delightfully "telling the story" of Etna for the enjoyment of both young and old.

Explore breathtaking landscapes, ancient craters of extraordinary beauty, or venture into a lava cave. Later, meet a local winemaker and gain insight into his daily life. This guided visit (optional: €60 per person – to be booked in advance) to one of the region's finest wineries is paired with a tasting of delicious Sicilian specialities.

Next, let's head to our new accommodation and unwind after this eventful day.

Required equipment: closed-toe shoes, a windbreaker, waterproof clothing, a hat or head covering, a cap, and 1.5L of water.

# Day 11: Exploring Ortigia and Syracuse (Meals: B-; Transport: approx. 1h30)

Let's discover Syracuse, and Ortigia in particular, from a different perspective. If you wish, we can head to the Syracuse Archaeological Park for a guided visit (with audio guide – optional).

Next, let's head to the heart of Ortigia. With the help of our guide, we'll choose a trattoria that suits us, enjoy an exquisite lunch, and spend the afternoon strolling at leisure, exploring the city—including its intriguing underground passages.

At the end of the day, let's not miss a stroll along the lungomare and soak up the serene beauty of a magnificent sunset. If time and inclination allow, a short walk or hike at Plemmerio can also enrich our afternoon.

## Day 12: Transfer to Catania Airport (Meals: B-; Transport: approx. 45 min)

Final moments in this magical place, on this enchanting island, before our journey back home.

Free time depending on our flight schedule, followed by a transfer to Catania Airport.

## **Trip Extension**

This 12-day programme offers a wonderful insight into the treasures of the island, its rich history, and its diverse, enchanting landscapes.

We can only recommend that travellers extend their stay by at least three days — and why not double it? If that's not possible, then you'll simply have to return to this fabulous island, with your heart full of joy!
