Day 1: Palermo (Meals: --D; Transport: 2h15)

Arrival in Palermo and transfer to Castelbuono. Meet your guide, followed by some free time. In the evening, enjoy a home-cooked dinner with your hosts: your guides welcome you into their home for a friendly, relaxed meal – a perfect chance to meet, chat, and get to know one another. *Note: In the event of a late arrival, the first dinner will be scheduled on another evening.*

Accommodation: Castelbuono - cosy apartments in local homes.

Day 2: In Search of the Essence of Sicily - Through the Streets (and Pastry Shops) of Castelbuono (Meals: B-D; Transport: none)

We start the day like true Sicilians, with a cappuccino or espresso in one of the cafés in Castelbuono's historic centre. Then we set out to explore the old quarters: laundry hanging from balconies, tempting aromas of local dishes, churches around every corner, men chatting in the circoli, and playful patterns of light and shadow under the Mediterranean sun... this is Sicily!

Along the way, we sample local specialities and meet passionate artisans. We also visit the Castle, built 700 years ago by the Ventimiglia family, one of the island's most powerful noble dynasties. Inside its impressive Baroque chapel are the relics of Saint Anne, the town's patron saint. Lunch is shared with a Sicilian family. The late afternoon is free, with

dinner and the evening at leisure.

Day 3: Discovering the Natural Riches of the Madonie Park (Meals: B-D; Transport: 40 min)

In the morning, we set off on a hike along the Trail of Monumental Trees (approx. $3\frac{1}{2}$ hours including breaks). Here we encounter the incredible natural wealth of the Madonie, one of the Mediterranean's most biodiverse areas. Rare plants, centuries-old trees, and panoramic views (on clear days, Mount Etna is visible!) punctuate the route. We pause in a forest of giant holm oaks reaching up to 20 metres high. The atmosphere here is utterly unique, mysterious, and surreal – straight out of a fairytale.

After a picnic lunch, we visit Castelbuono's Natural History Museum, housed in a former convent. Its surprising collections showcase the rich variety of local flora, fauna, and geology. The late afternoon is free, with dinner and evening at leisure.

Day 4: Cefalù (Meals: BLD; Transport: 1h)

We set off for Cefalù, the region's main seaside town, renowned for its Arab-Norman cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Our day begins with a climb up the Rocca, a massive rock overlooking the town, offering spectacular panoramic views. We then descend into the old quarters to visit the porticciolo (small harbour), the medieval washhouse, and, of course, the impressive cathedral. This fascinating mix of Nordic architecture, Arab influences, and Byzantine mosaics reflects the multicultural society that thrived in Sicily during the Middle Ages.

At lunchtime, we enjoy arancini (stuffed and fried rice balls) and panelle (chickpea flour fritters), iconic Sicilian street food, at a café in the historic centre. The afternoon is free – perfect for a swim or simply relaxing. Dinner and the evening are at leisure.

Day 5: Immersion in the Sicilian Countryside (Meals B-L; Transport: 30 min)

Mario welcomes you onto his land at the foot of the Madonie mountains, immersing you in a world where traditions are not just history, but very much a way of life.

The morning begins with a guided walk to explore traditional crops, edible wild plants, and local medicinal herbs. Mario will reveal the secrets of manna, produced from the ash tree – Castelbuono's famous speciality... but we won't spoil the surprise just yet! Depending on the season, you may take part in various activities such as harvesting, sowing, preparing traditional balms, or tree grafting, before enjoying a tasting of local specialities. Dinner and the evening are at leisure.

Day 6: Exploring the Caves (Meals: BL-; Transport: 20 min)

Today's excursion takes us to an area of great geological interest, where the limestone rock shelters natural caves as well as fossils of corals and other forms of life that once inhabited the region's seas millions of years ago. We explore two small, easily accessible caves and pause at the edge of a chasm (safely enclosed by a railing). Along the trail, we enjoy spectacular panoramic views of the lower Madonie, Castelbuono, and the Tyrrhenian coast. A picnic lunch is taken at a small mountain refuge. Dinner and the evening are at leisure.

Day 7: The Madonie Tour (Meals BL-; Transport: 3h)

Today we drive across the Carbonara Massif, the highest mountains in Sicily after Mount Etna. We set off early for Isnello, a small village nestled at the foot of the Monte Grotta Grande cliffs. We wander through the maze of medieval streets and climb up to the ruins of the old castle.

From there, we continue into the high mountains. The route includes stops at the region's most stunning natural sites. We pass remarkable geological formations that tell the story of the Madonie and support an exceptional range of biodiversity. Along the way, we pause at locations steeped in fascinating tales of shepherds and bandits, encounter one of the oldest trees in the Madonie, and come face-to-face with a cliff where the golden eagle nests.

Day 8: Palermo (Meals B--; Transport: 2h15)

Departure for Palermo. Depending on flight times, there may be an opportunity to visit the archaeological site of Himera, once a thriving Greek city, or to enjoy a final stroll through Palermo.
